Dear neighborhood homeowners and guests,

Please be advised that our neighborhoods have had recent incidents of vehicle burglaries. Thieves are targeting unlocked vehicles with valuables left inside. Wallets, purses, money, lap-tops and expensive recreational equipment are some of the items which have been stolen out of unlocked vehicles.

Recently, a firearm was stolen out of an unlocked vehicle. The Eagle Police Department recommends proper storage of firearms and cautions owners of the potential liability in leaving a firearm in an unlocked vehicle that is parked in a public area.

To ensure thieves understand our Town is not a target for their illicit activities, please remain diligent by continuing to remove any valuables in your car. Additionally, keep your car and garage locked when unattended.

Please remain aware of any suspicious vehicles or people in your neighborhood. The low incidents of crime in Eagle continue due to citizens and guests remaining aware of suspicious incidents and actively engaging in crime prevention efforts. Prompt notifications of suspicious incidents to our police dispatch center by members of our community have also led to a variety of interventions with positive impact to our philosophy of crime prevention.

Please continue to promptly contact the police upon any signs of suspicious activity, persons or vehicles in our neighborhoods.
