Town Manager Candidate Meet & Greet May 25, 2022 5:30 - 7:30 pm

The Town of Eagle announces the 4 finalists to be considered for the Town Manager position. The Town contracted with KRW Associates to conduct a nationwide search for the new Town Manager. The opportunity attracted 22 applicants from which the finalists were selected. The finalists are interviewing on May 25 and 26 for the final selection process. There will also be a community reception open to the public to meet the candidates.

The finalists are:

Bentley Henderson – Mr. Henderson is currently the Assistant County Manager for Summit County, Colorado. He has been in that position for the past three years. Mr. Henderson has over 20 years of local government experience and has served in several Colorado mountain communities including Carbondale, Aspen, Basalt, Archuleta County and Summit County. He holds a Master of Arts Degree in Public Administration from the University of Colorado and a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Business Administration from Fort Lewis College in Durango, Colorado.

Jennifer Ooton – Ms. Ooton is currently the Assistant City Manager in Glenwood Springs, Colorado. She has been in that position for the past five years and is primarily responsible for Economic and Community Development. She has twelve years of local government experience and previously worked for the City of Lafayette, Colorado where she was responsible for Public Information, Community Development and also served as the Director of the Lafayette Urban Renewal Authority and Downtown Coordinator. She holds a Master's Degree in Public Administration from the University of Colorado and a Bachelor of Science Degree in Journalism from the University of Colorado.

Rachel Oys – Ms. Oys currently works as a private consultant to government and nonprofit agencies. She previously served for six years as the General Manager of the Cordillera Metro District and Property Owners Association. She also served as the Assistant County Manager for Eagle County and was asked to serve as the Interim County

Manager during the executive search for the permanent county manager. For five years she was the Executive Director and Public Health Director for Eagle County. She holds a Juris Doctorate from the University of Denver College of Law, a Master's Degree in Public Policy from the University of Denver School of International Studies and a Bachelor's Degree from the University of Denver.

Larry Pardee – For the past four years, Mr. Pardee has served as the Town Manager for Jackson, Wyoming. He has over 35 years of local government experience and was formerly the Public Works Director for the Town of Jackson, Wyoming. For five years he was the manager for Streets and Maintenance for the Town of Vail, Colorado. He attended the International City Managers Senior Executive Institute at the University of Virginia.
